As the impact of the Coronavirus (COVID-19) continues to escalate, the latest order by Pennsylvania Governor Wolf to close non-essential businesses does not affect Yazoo Mills, Inc. Yazoo Mills is exempt as a converted paper product manufacturer. We are in the supply chain to many “essential” or “critical” businesses and industries of life sustaining nature. Among the life-sustaining industries we support are food manufacturing, agriculture, plastic and rubber manufacturing, primary metal manufacturing, medical equipment and supplies and merchant wholesalers and healthcare.

Yazoo Mills does not expect any impact on our service as a result of the Coronavirus. Yazoo Mills has two facilities that produce tubes and cores. All of our main raw materials are domestically sourced through several locations using vendors that also have multiple locations. No raw materials are imported. We are comfortable that the exclusive use of domestic sources, their back-up facilities and our own back up facility and inventory levels will mitigate any potential disruption in your supply chain due to the coronavirus.

We are currently operating in full production mode and taking steps to educate our employees in the recommendations from the CDC and WHO as well as those from the U.S. Government, so we can do our part in preventing the spread of COVID-19.

The current situation is evolving quickly. Yazoo Mills is continuing to closely monitor the latest developments regarding the Coronavirus (COVID-19) globally and any potential impact it may have on the continuity of our operations.
